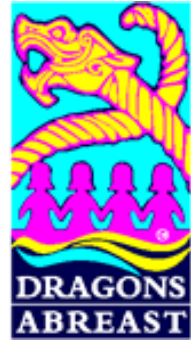


DRAGONS ABREAST ACT & REGION

Team Requirements

Two free training sessions are offered as part of the lead up to the regatta.

Mixed teams – must have a minimum of 8 women paddlers (excluding drummer & sweep who can be provided for you.)

Womens teams – all women (excluding drummer and sweep).

No more than four competitive (ie from a sports team) paddlers on a team.

Competitive paddlers must be part, or associated with, the organisation.

Your organisation may enter two teams; however each team must meet the above requirements with no paddler 'doubling up' by participating in more than one team/boat.

Team lists to have 20 paddlers plus up to 4 alternates.

CDBA is able to provide sweeps and drummers as required.
