 or you can cherish her memory and let it live on.

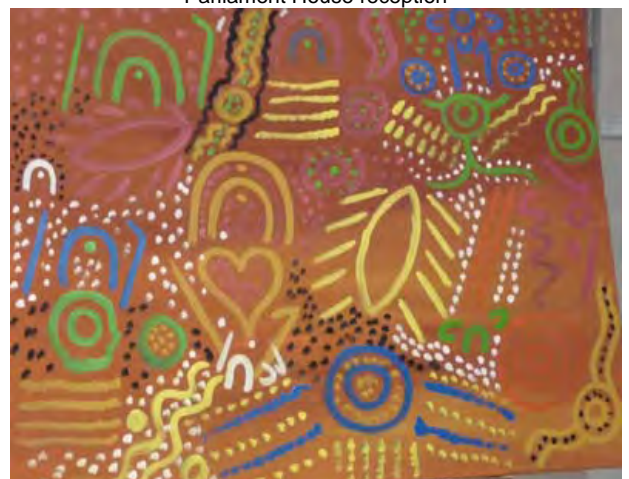
You can cry and close your mind,
