Teams May Not be comprised of more than 50% males.

Handicaps MAY apply depending on the paddling ability of the teams entered.

An entry fee of \$20 per paddler will apply. This entitles you to breakfast at the Darwin.

Safety boats will accompany the dragon boats for the round trip.

ENTRIES CLOSE 21st April 2006

Conditions of Entry

1. All entrants will abide by the race rules and regulations of Dragon Boat Northern Territory (DBNT), whose decision in all matters relating thereto and to the suitability and eligibility of entrants is final and binding.
2. Registered entrants receive personal (on water) accident insurance through DBNT upon payment of the registration fee for the event.
3. All entrants waiver any claim on the event organisers which may otherwise arise from personal injury or death and damage arising from or caused by participation in the event.
4. The entrant(s) will reimburse the event organisers for any damages or losses caused by the entrant to equipment provided by the event organisers.
5. Entrants will utilise only equipment and fittings provided or required by the event organisers.
6. All crews will be allocated a DBNT accredited Sweep. Crews will carry out all instructions issued by the Sweep.
7. Every crew member must be able to swim 50 metres in light clothing or otherwise wear a personal floatation device. These will be available upon request. All entrants 18 years and under will be required to wear a personal floatation device.
8. Any protest must be lodged with the Adjudication Panel within 10 minutes of the result announcement. The protest must be lodged on the Protest form, which will be available from the Adjudication Panel. The Team Manager must lodge the protest form. A protest fee of \$100.00 in cash must accompany each protest. If the protest is unsuccessful the protest fee will not be refunded. If the protest is successful the protest fee will be refunded and the race result will be determined by the Adjudication Panel, which may or may not include a re-run of the race in question at the Adjudication Panel's discretion.
